Call to Prayer

Leader:

Scripture: Luke 12:22-31

Pause for silent reflection

Psalm Response - Psalm 27

Antiphon

(All): I shall see the goodness of God in the land of the living.

Reader 1: O God, You are my light and my salvation.

> Whom should I fear? You are my refuge

Of whom should I be afraid?

(All): I shall see the goodness of God in the land of the living.

Reader 2: One thing I ask of You,

This I seek:

To dwell in Your holy house All the days of my life.

Reader 3: Though an army encamp against me,

My heart will not fear;

Though war be waged upon me,

Even then I will trust You.

(All): I shall see the goodness of God in the land of the living.

Reader 4: I believe I shall see Your goodness

In the land of the living.

Teach me how to wait for You with courage,

All the days of my life.

Pause for silent reflection. (Play some instrumental music.)

Leader: O God, your daughter Julie was a woman of great courage who challenged

the church she loved;

All: —may the church make known your compassion and justice for all.

Leader: Julie's heart was filled with a deep love for the poor and needy;

All: —open our eyes and hearts to all those we serve.

Leader: For many years, Julie was paralyzed;

All: —give strength to all those who are suffering and physically disabled.

Leader: You blessed Julie with a spirit of simplicity and gave her a love for prayer;

All: —free our lives from all the clutter, so that we can have space and time for you.

Leader: Let us join in praying together the prayer Jesus taught us to say:

All: Our Father.
